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❖ <b>First Visit</b>	Office Visit 1-2 days after discharge	Hep B, if not given in hospital
❖ <b>2 Weeks</b>	Well Child Exam	No immunizations given
❖ <b>2 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib), Prevnar, Hep B & Oral Rotavirus
❖ <b>4 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib), Prevnar & Oral Rotavirus
❖ <b>6 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib), Prevnar & Oral Rotavirus
❖ <b>9 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Hep B
❖ <b>12 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib), Prevnar, fingerstick blood test to check Iron & lead levels.
❖ <b>15 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	MMR & Varivax
❖ <b>18 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Hep A & M-Chat Questionnaire
❖ <b>2 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	Hep A; lead test if high-risk, M-Chat
❖ <b>30 Months</b>	Well Child Exam	Catch-up on immunizations if needed
❖ <b>3 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	No routine Immunizations, Vision check
❖ <b>4 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	DTaP, IPV, Vision & Hearing tests
❖ <b>5 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	MMR, Varivax, Vision & Hearing tests
❖ <b>6 - 10 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	Catch up vaccination if needed
❖ <b>11 - 12 Year</b>	Well Child Exam	Tdap, HPV & Menactra
❖ <b>13 Year &amp; Older</b>	Annual Exam	Fingerstick blood test to check Iron & lead levels Catch up vaccination as needed
❖ <b>College Entry</b>	Exam	No routine immunizations or lab tests unless required by the college
